At a Regular Meeting of the City Council of Williamston, Ingham County, Michigan held in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 161 E. Grand River Avenue, Williamston, Michigan on Monday, September 26, 2016 at 7:00 p.m., there were:

The following resolution was offered by Gilroy and supported by Bertolino.

COIN ACCEPTANCE POLICY

WHEREAS, under State law, MCL 21.153, a municipality is not required to receive in payment of any debt or taxes anything other than U.S. currency and gold or silver coin; and

WHEREAS, the City of Williamston recognizes the necessity for efficient processing of payments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The following policy shall govern the guidelines for accepting coins tendered for payment.

1. Acceptable Coin Amounts.

Except as otherwise provided herein, the City will not accept more than twenty coins for any individual payment of any debts or obligations owed to the City.

2. Exception; Fee; Waiver.

The City may accept more than twenty coins for an individual payment of a debt or obligation owed to the City, provided the payment includes a coin processing fee equal to 5% of the original payment.

2.1 The City Treasurer may waive the coin processing fee, provided the dollar amount of the coins does not exceed \$20.00 and the coins are wrapped in coin wrappers containing the customer's name, address and telephone number in the categories listed below:

Pennies:	0.50¢ roll wrapper
Nickels:	\$2.00 roll wrapper
Dimes:	\$5.00 roll wrapper
Quarter:	\$10.00 roll wrapper


